# What Does the Marin County Commission on Aging Do?

## Answer: Information and Advocacy

Marin County has one of the fastest growing older adult populations in California. Currently 31% of Marin’s population is age 60+ compared to 20% statewide and the County’s older adult population is anticipated to continue growing through 2040, at a minimum.

The Marin County Commission on Aging is federally mandated by the Older Americans Act to serve as an advocate for older adults and an advisory council to the Marin County Board of Supervisors and the Marin Area Agency on Aging, part of Marin’s Aging and Adult Services. The Commission:

- Advocates, educates, communicates, and collaborates with older adults, caregivers, and community stakeholders supporting older adults in areas that may impact older adult welfare including housing, health care, nutrition, transportation, financial security, and other concerns.
- Promotes the understanding and need for positive changes in Marin County for older adults and their caregivers by listening and advocating their needs for quality of life, independence, dignity, equity, respect, collaboration, inclusions and addressing ageism and ableism in the community.

- Provides a forum for public feedback and involvement.
- Through community outreach raises awareness on aging topics and issues.

Commissioners represent their respective cities, towns and districts and are appointed to three-year terms by either the Board of Supervisors or their City or Town Councils. Everyone is welcome to attend our meetings and participate in our discussions on issues impacting older adults.

Referrals to resources and services for older adults are available by contacting 415-473-INFO (4636). Social workers answer and return calls Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Marin County’s Aging and Adult Services also has a resource guide for older adults available on the County’s website.
